**What's on the CLEP Principles of Management**

The Principles of Management examination covers material that is equivalent to a semester of college credit. The exam consists of 100 questions and takes 90 minutes to complete. The exam fee is \$80 and the passing score is 50.

Test takers that pass the Principles of Management CLEP exam will receive a three semester hours of college credit.

There are 2 calculations performed to get the final score. The raw score is first calculated based on the questions answered correctly. The raw score is then converted into a scaled score that ranges from 20 to 80. The final scaled score is the score that appears on the exam results page.
